Dear Member,

I recently wrote you to let you know that the Patrick Administration was working on a way to keep medical coverage for certain legal immigrants. These immigrants lost Commonwealth Care coverage on August 31, 2009, because of recent changes in state law.

I am very pleased to let you know that we have been successful in making arrangements with a health plan called CeltiCare. CeltiCare will provide most of the coverage you were able to get from your Commonwealth Care plan. We are working hard to get this coverage in place.

We will not be able to enroll everyone who lost Commonwealth Care coverage into the new health plan at the same time. We will start enrollments in the new plan in October 2009. We will make every effort to get all members enrolled in the new plan by December 2009.

The Health Connector will work with CeltiCare to start your new coverage. The Health Connector will send you a letter when they are ready to enroll you in the new plan. You will also get a letter from CeltiCare after you are enrolled. You will get all the information that you need about the new health plan. This will include the places that you can get care, the services that are covered, and information about copayments.

In the meantime, you may get some services from certain hospitals and community health centers through the Health Safety Net or MassHealth Limited.

Thank you for your continued patience. We will all work as quickly as possible, but it may take until December to enroll everyone.
