We are seeking an attorney willing to work at least 30 hours per week and to make a moderate or long term commitment to the office.

The attorney will have the opportunity to work with clients and advocacy groups in a wide cross section of disability law, including working with people with physical disabilities, psychiatric disabilities, intellectual disabilities and traumatic brain injury.

Our office is committed to providing volunteers with supervision, training and support to promote professional development.
