The Department will stop your Food Stamp benefits on 06/06/2014 because you and /or a household member do not meet the program's rules because you are a resident of an institution that provides the majority of your meals.

If you become eligible to receive public assistance such as TAFDC, EAEDC, SSI or the SSI State Supplement, you may become eligible for food stamp benefits.

The regulation(s) used in reaching these decisions are 106 CMR: 361.240.

You are entitled to Food Stamp benefits, if eligible, without regard to age, race, color, sex, handicap, religious creed, national origin, or political beliefs.
