MOTION TO TERMINATE REGISTRATION

Now comes \_\_\_\_\_ (date of birth, address, sex offender number) and moves that the Sex Offender Registry Board terminate his registration obligation pursuant to 803 C.M.R. 1.37B, and relieve him of his obligation to register as a sex offender, in accordance with G.L.c. 6, § 178G.

As grounds therefore, \_\_\_\_\_ states the following:

1. It has been at least ten years following his conviction, adjudication or release from all custody or supervision, whichever is later.
2. \_\_\_\_\_'s registration and classification determination has become final and is not under judicial review or appeal.
3. There are no pending charges against \_\_\_\_\_ and he is not presently incarcerated.
4. \_\_\_\_\_ is eligible for termination of his registration obligation because he has not been determined to be a sexually violent predator, has not been convicted of two or more Wetterling Offenses committed on different occasions, has not been convicted of a sexually violent offense and has not been convicted of a sex offense

involving a child (or “*he was convicted of a sex offense involving a child and has already been registered for at least ten years*”)

5. \_\_\_\_\_ has not committed a sex offense within ten years following the date of conviction, adjudication or release from custody or supervision, whichever last occurs.
6. New and updated information establishes that \_\_\_\_\_ is not likely to pose a danger to the safety of others.
7. \_\_\_\_\_ refers the Board to the attached documentary evidence and

Memorandum of Law in further support of his motion.
