

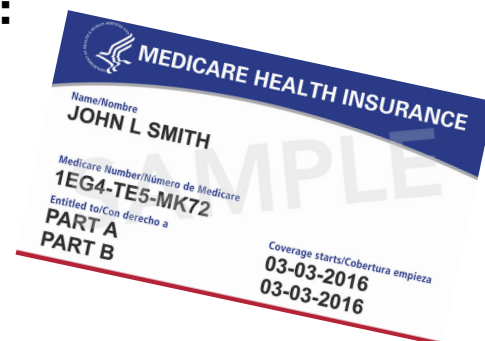
# WANT HELP PAYING FOR YOUR MEDICARE COVERAGE?

The Massachusetts Medicare Savings Programs (MSP) may help!

These federally funded programs will pay for your:

- Monthly Medicare Part B premium (\$164.90/mo)
- Prescription drug costs (premium & co-pays)
- **And for some**, the Medicare Part A and Part B out-of-pocket costs (deductibles & co-insurance)



## NEW EXPANDED ELIGIBILITY

### Are you eligible?

You may qualify if your income and assets are at or below the amounts listed here:

#### January/ February 2023

	Monthly Income	Assets*
Single Person	\$ 2,568	\$ 18,180
Married Couple	\$ 3,458	\$ 27,260

#### Starting March 1, 2023

	Monthly Income	Assets*
Single Person	\$ 2,754	\$ 18,180
Married Couple	\$ 3,718	\$ 27,260

\*Your home, car, and life insurance are **NOT** counted as Assets.
