In these hard times, older people in Massachusetts depend on a variety of benefits programs to meet their income and health needs. This program provides legal services advocates, lawyers, paralegals, social and health services workers, and community activists with an overview and basic knowledge of the public resources available to elders. Experts will review the basic eligibility rules for cash benefit programs like SSI and Social Security Insurance benefits, home-based care services from the Office of Elder Affairs, and health care programs like Medicare and MassHealth. Participants receive detailed materials.
