Lift Kids Out of Deep Poverty Please co-sponsor Rep. Decker's Amendment # 83

Please co-sponsor Amendment #83 to Lift Kids Out of Deep Poverty.

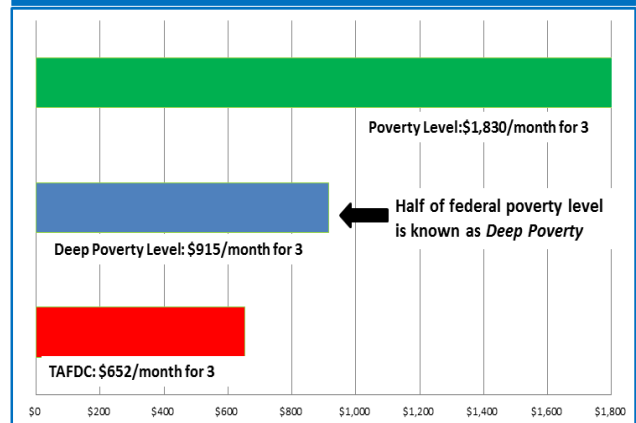
- “Deep poverty” is income below *half* the federal poverty level - \$915/month for a family of three.
- Even with the recent 10% increase, the maximum TAFDC grant for a family of three is still only \$652/month.
- The EAEDC grant for a single disabled or elderly person is only \$334/month.
- HWM kept the recent 10% increase but left grants far below poverty.
- The amendment would increase grants by 20% to bring us one step closer to ending Deep Poverty, providing critical support to 26,000 families with children and 20,000 elders and persons with disabilities.

How much will this cost?

- No additional funds needed for TAFDC; \$15.1M for EAEDC.

A majority of House and Senate members have sponsored the bills to Lift Kids Out of Deep Poverty, H199 and S96.
