Introduction The Active CAT 2 Cases With DEP Act #79 Report has been sent to local offices or was distributed at the Quality Control Meeting on July 26, 1996. Please disregard the report distributed at Statewide on July 24, 1996. This memo provides local offices with instructions regarding the report. Definitions For AFDC AR 79 indicates any teen dependent who is not meeting the school attendance requirements. For TAFDC AR 79 indicates a TEEN PARENT dependent who is not meeting the school attendance requirements. For TAFDC AR 81 indicates a teen dependent (other than a TEEN PARENT) who is not meeting the school attendance requirements. **Review the Case** Local office workers must review each case on the report to determine if AR 79 reflects the correct reason for the Record dependent closing.

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Reminders

Result of the Case

Record Review

When reviewing the cases remember:

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o A TAFDC dependent, who is not a teen parent, may have correctly closed for AR 79. This is because the termination was based on AFDC requirements and initiated prior the TAFDC transition review.

A TAFDC Teen Parent is considered to have met the school attendance requirements and therefore not sanctioned:

1) when the teen parent has taken appropriate steps to begin meeting the requirements and provided a statement or other verification from the school or GED program that he or she is enrolled and will begin when the school or program is available; or

 failure to meet the school attendance requirements is the result of one of the good cause reasons described in 106 CMR 207.190 (A).

If the dependent was receiving **AFDC** and AR 79 was used and:

- o *was the correct reason*, no further case action is necessary; or
- o was not the correct reason for the closing, then reinstate the dependent back to the closing date and then close the dependent using the correct Action Reason.

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If the dependent was a **TAFDC TEEN PARENT** and AR 79 was used and the teen parent:

o was not meeting the school attendance requirements and was sanctioned appropriately, no further case action is necessary;

o. was meeting the school attendance requirements and was incorrectly sanctioned, reinstate the teen parent back to the closing date; or

o should have been sanctioned for a reason other than AR 79, then reinstate the teen parent back to the closing date and then close the teen parent using the correct Action Reason.

If the dependent was a **TAFDC teen dependent** but not a TEEN PARENT then:

o reinstate the dependent back to the closing date and then close the dependent using the correct Action Reason.

Completion Date	By Wednesday, August 7, 1996 local office workers must:
	o review the cases and key enter changes to the system, if any; and
	 annotate the reports to reflect the result of the case review and submit them to the director or designee.
Summary Sheets	Summary Sheets (see Attachment A) for each local office must be compiled by the director or designee and submitted to Central Office on or before Wednesday , August 7, 1996. The reports do not have to be sent to Central Office.
