## To: Local Office Staff From: Joyce Sampson, Assistant Commissioner for Field Operations Re: Food Stamp Program - Teen Parent Structured Living Placements

As part of the signed agreement between the teen parent and the Structured Living Program (TLP), the teen parent will be required to give her food stamp allotment to the TLP. The TLP will use the food stamp benefits to buy food for the teen parent and her child(ren) and instruct the teen in proper nutrition, food purchase, food preparation and budgeting.

Local offices must support the TLPs by telling teen parents about this requirement. If a teen parent questions this requirement, instruct the teen parent that contributing the food stamp benefits is a condition of living in the TLP.

Use the Payment Standard for Exempt Assistance Units with No Rent Allowance (see 106 CMR 204.420) to determine the amount of food stamp benefits for teen parents and their children. The shelter costs of teen parents residing in TLPs for food stamp calculation purposes shall be the portion of the cash grant contributed to the TLP. The teen parents have no utility costs for food stamp calculation purposes.
