Re:

Rieconversion Clean-up of Noncitizen Cases Eligible for State Supplemental Food Stamp Benefits

Background

Under the 1997 Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act which President Clinton signed on June 12, 1997 states were given the option to issue state-funded food stamp benefits to certain individuals made ineligible by federal welfare reform. On July 11, 1997 Governor Weld signed into law a State Supplemental Food Stamp Program (SSFSP) for certain noncitizens.

Field Operations Memos 97-47A, 97-52, 97-53, 97-54 and 97-55 provided instructions for coding food stamp cases/dependents who were determined ineligible for Food Stamp Program (FS) benefits based <u>solely</u> on ineligible noncitizen status. Appropriate coding of these cases/dependents in accordance with these memos will enable the system to:

- ♦ issue EBT SSFSP benefits for September and October; and
- ◆ automatically convert most of these cases/ dependents to the SSFSP for November 1997 cyclical food stamp benefits.

This memo provides instructions for a preconversion clean-up of cases which are not coded appropriately at this time.

Two clean-up reports will be generated and faxed to local offices today. Each attachment to this memo provides coding instructions for cases/dependents listed on the identified report.

Attachment A: Food Stamp Cases/Dependents Closed for AR 44 - No Filing Unit Entry (Category 2 and 4 Cash Assistance Case Remains Active)

Note: This report was run in two parts: PA/FS cases closed for AR 44 and PA/FS dependents closed for AR 44.

Attachment B: Food Stamp Cases/Dependents Pending to Close for AR 44 - No Filing Unit Entry

The worker must annotate these reports with the action taken, and retained until the conversion process is completed.

Note: Additional clean-up reports will be developed and distributed to local offices, as needed before SSFSP conversion.

- coded on or before September 25, 1997 for September and October EBT SSFSP benefit issuance; and
- ♦ coded for automatic conversion to SSFSP benefits for the November cyclical issuance.
