

Are you a College Student Struggling to Afford Food?



You might be eligible for grocery food cards up to \$234/month from the SNAP program during COVID. Students with spouses or children may be eligible for more.*

Most low income students who meet any of the following are SNAP eligible including:

- Students in community colleges
- Students who were awarded work study - even if they currently don't have a work study job on campus
- Students who were awarded a MassGrant
- Students who have an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of \$0

*Students need to meet other SNAP rules, learn more about SNAP and the benefit amounts at mass.gov/SNAP
