The MBTA Youth Pass Program provides affordable access to public transportation for low-income youth and young adults. This includes many DTA clients.

Purpose

The purpose of this transmittal is to inform DTA staff that six cities and towns have been added to the list of MBTA Youth Pass participating communities. These are Arlington, Brookline, Everett, Lexington, Medford and Watertown.
