Re: SNAP: SNAP Waived Recertification Interview Procedural Clarification

Overview

SNAP recertification interviews may be waived for households where all adult members are elderly and/or disabled and there is no earned income. Households with minor children are also eligible for this waiver provided the previous conditions are met.

Staff are reminded that a recertification interview that would otherwise be waived, must be conducted if the household would be denied at recertification.

Purpose

The purpose of this transmittal is to advise staff of updates made to the Online Guide to clarify when an interview must be held or waived.
