Re: SNAP: Update to Asset Limits in the Online Guide

Overview

In September 2021, Online Guide Transmittal 2021-71 detailed the 2021 cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) for SNAP. As part of this COLA, the asset limit for non-categorically-eligible households with an elderly and/or disabled member increased to \$3,750, and the asset limit for all other households increased to \$2,500.

The Online Guide is now updated to reflect these changes to the asset limits.

Purpose

The purpose of this Online Guide Transmittal is to advise staff of the Online Guide updates related to the asset limits that increased due to the 2021 COLA.
