Re: Cross Program: The Essential Employee Premium Pay Program

Overview

On December 13, 2021, Governor Baker signed into law the COVID-19 Essential Employee Premium Pay Program. This premium pay program, the first of its type in the nation, will distribute a \$500 payment to 500,000 low-income workers across Massachusetts.

The one-time lump sum payment received from the Employee Premium Pay Program of \$500 is considered non-countable for SNAP, TAFDC, and EAEDC.

Purpose

The purpose of this Transmittal is to advise staff of The Essential Employee Premium Pay Program and stipulate that income received from this program is noncountable for Economic Assistance and SNAP.
