Overview On December 13, 2021, Governor Baker signed into law the COVID-19 Essential Employee Premium Pay Program. This premium pay program, the first of its type in the nation, will distribute a \$500 payment to 500,000 low-income workers across Massachusetts.

> The one-time lump sum payment received from the Employee Premium Pay Program of \$500 is considered non-countable for SNAP, TAFDC, and EAEDC.

this program is noncountable for Economic Assistance and SNAP.
