Re: EAEDC: Extension and Redesignation of Temporary Protected Status (TPS) for Yemen

Overview

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) has announced the extension and re-designation of Yemen for Temporary Protected Status (TPS) for 18 months. This extension and re-designation will be in effect from March 4, 2023 through September 3, 2024.

Individuals who are approved or have pending status for TPS are considered Permanently Residing Under Color of Law (PRUCOL) for purposes of EAEDC eligibility, and accordingly, may be eligible for EAEDC provided they meet all other EAEDC nonfinancial and financial requirements.

Important: Individuals who are approved or pending for TPS are not eligible for SNAP or TAFDC benefits, **unless** they qualify under a different noncitizen status, i.e., Refugee.

Purpose

This Transmittal advises staff about the continued designation of TPS for Yemen.
