To ensure everyone has access to critical Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits, DTA requires Transitional Aid to Families with Dependent Children (TAFDC) and Emergency Aid to the Elderly, Disabled and Children (EAEDC) case managers to inform TAFDC and EAEDC applicants and clients of potential eligibility for SNAP benefits during the application interview and reevaluation interviews.
