Re:	TAFDC: Elimination of the Cash Advance deduction for Child Support Income		
Overview	Effective immediately, child support income received from the date of TAFDC application until the date TAFDC benefits are authorized will not be deducted from the first grant payment by way of a Cash Advance deduction. Child support income received in the four weeks prior to TAFDC application will continue to be counted and used in the determination of financial eligibility.		
Purpose	The purpose of this Online Guide Transmittal is to advise staff of this change in counting child support income for TAFDC and updated corresponding Online Guide pages pertaining to entering the child support income in BEACON.		
Case Manager Responsibilities	Staff must not create a Cash Advance deduction in the related benefit window to account for child support received while a TAFDC application is pending.
