Medex Premium Rate Changes

Introduction

Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Massachusetts has announced Medex premium rate changes to six non-group plans: Basic, Bronze, Gold, Standard, Core and Silver. These changes were effective on March 25, 2002.

This memo:

- identifies the non-group plans that have changed and the corresponding rate changes;
- identifies the date of the changes and the effect these changes will have on the amount of food stamp benefits;
- transmits information for the Medex Premium Rate Update Report;
- provides information of updates to food stamp benefits and the Medex premium amounts.

Identifying Recipients Enrolled in Medex

AU Managers are reminded of the importance of identifying recipients enrolled in Medex. To ensure AU accuracy and the correct calculation of food stamp benefits, Medex premium payments must be entered on the Health Insurance Window, Policy Tab. Refer to A User's Guide: Transitional Assistance Programs and BEACON, Chapter XIV- J.

Updated BEACON

BEACON screens have been updated with the new food stamp benefit amounts and/or new Medex premium amounts, if appropriate, as follows:

• the new food stamp benefit amounts will be displayed on the *Results Tab* for non-pended transactions and on *Interview Wrap-up* with a status of *Pending Release* for pended transactions;

Note: The transaction will pend only if the Medex premium update results in a decrease or there is another transaction pending in Interview Wrap-up.

• the new Medex premium amount will be displayed on the *Health Insurance Window, Policy Tab.*
